



In an effort to improve the safety and overall process of damage prevention to buried cable and underground infrastructure in Manitoba, the Winnipeg Airports Authority (WAA) is a registered utility owner with the Click Before You Dig Manitoba service.

Winnipeg Richardson International Airport is a unique environment with many buried private and public utilities on and adjacent to the airport lands. All excavation and ground disturbance must be approved by WAA and will require underground utility clearances for all registered utilities prior to breaking ground. WAA utility locators are dispatched through the Click Before You Dig Manitoba program.

Requests for buried cable and infrastructure locates should be made at least 5 working days prior to excavation.

WAA will contact you when you are cleared to excavate.

If required WAA will attend the site to mark the location of WAA buried facilities. This marking will remain valid for 14 days. Delays in excavation beyond this time will require a new locate request.

*\*Requests for locates with Click Before You Dig Manitoba reach a large number of buried facility owners in Manitoba who have registered to use the Click Before You Dig Manitoba service, but to notify facility owners who have not subscribed to the Click Before You Dig Manitoba service, a separate individual request to those facility owners is required.*
